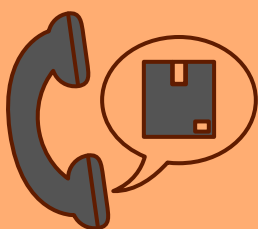

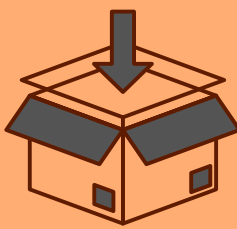

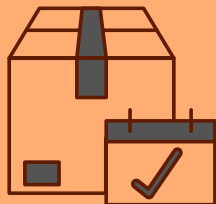
STEPS TO GET A GOOD BOX



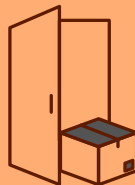
1. Place order for a good box and pay via Paypal.



2. Email items for our "personal shoppers" and/or fill shopping cart on the website. Pay before orders are purchased.



3. Confirm customs declaration form of items before sealing.



4. Wait for the Good Box at your doorstep within 4-8 weeks after dispatch.

*Each customer must fill the box in 20 days. Beyond 20 days, box must be dispatched even if not full.

WHY THE GOOD BOX?

1. Website products carry the "Made in Japan" or "Exclusive Japan Export" quality assurance.
2. Compared to existing shopping sites, quality and authenticity are guaranteed as personally shopped products have actual store receipt, which will be used as basis for 10% shopping service fee.
3. Personal shoppers could be tasked to go to very cheap outlet stores for brand name items, or even at vintage/second-hand stores in Japan, known for their quality. For example, an authentic second-hand Prada or iconic Chanel bag could be purchased at 60,000 - 100,000 yen in Tokyo. Small apartments and four-season fashion cycle encourages high turnover of fashion purchases, making second-hand shops carry premium finds. Imported items are also generally cheaper because of trade regulations. For example, a Yeezy sells at 25,000 yen, while other cities, like Manila, sell it at 25,000 pesos (double the price).
4. Shop-pooling allows you to share shipping costs while letting you shop for the item you really want.
5. The Good Box is an economical, practical, and guilt-free way of spending, which even allows sustainable shopping (sparing pre-loved fashion items from going to the bin).
